- Family Support & Outreach Programs: The new facility will feature family resource areas and space for educational events and community initiatives.
- Enhanced Outdoor Space: The campus will feature two inclusive playgrounds, an outdoor therapy track, and outdoor green space for gardening and therapeutic time with nature.
